

- No. I To confirm the minutes of the last meeting of the
Executive Committee held on 20th July, 1987. (The

Prof. T.S. Murty, Director General apprised the
members of the Executive Committee about the action taken

- No. II To consider the letter from the Government for
the release of Rs. 3.50 lakh to M.P. State Organi-
sation Committee of Bharat Jan Vigyan Jatha.

Prof. T.S. Murty informed the members that 26 Peoples
Science Organisations from all over the country are jointly
organising Bharat Jan Vigyan Jatha. The zonal jathas will
start from the North, West, South, East and North-Eastern
regions, halting at over 500 locations, covering about 25000
people and converging on Bhopal for a massive rally
on 6th October over 1000 Scientists and 5000 teachers on the 6th
October, 1987.


The Organisation and activities of the Jatha is in the objectives of the Council and in particular following three schemes :-

1. Popularisation of Science
2. S&T Inputs for SC and ST and
3. S&T Inputs for Women

Prof. Murty further informed that the M.P. Council Science & Technology will identify 21 Science Clubs enroute Jatha so that these could serve as centres for the spread scientific awareness amongst people of that area.

The Executive Committee then approved the sanction of 3.50 lakh to State Organising Committee of Bharat Jan Jatha as desired by the State Government vide their order No. 541/1050/S&T/41/87, dated 7.10.1987.
